Launch Request – (For boats stored at Steamboat Wharf Marina Yard only; please check your preferred date below)

- Please indicate your boat launch date preference. Launches will generally occur on Thursday or Friday of the week you choose. The maximum number of boats launched each week is 12 boats. Scheduling is on a first-come first-served basis.
- If you cancel your scheduled launch, we cannot guarantee launching the following week.
- Crew labor to pilot your boat may be charged at \$100 per hour.
- We reserve the right to launch your boat any day of the requested launch week, but most will be on Thursday or Friday. We will keep you informed of our plans. Your actual launch date will depend on tides, weather, and availability of hydraulic trailers.
- Work done by owners must be completed prior to Monday of the launch week. Note: DIYers must sign in, and adhere to all Standard Operating Procedures (copies available on the web: http://www.steamboatwharfmarina.com/s/SOP-Boat_Owner_Work_2015Nov.pdf)
- Non-Slip customers will be provided with 24 hours of free dockage, space permitting, unless prior arrangements have been made.

More than 24 hours: normal guest dockage rates (\$3.00 per foot per night) will be applied to your bill.

☐ **Standard Spring Commissioning Services always include the following:**

Work billed at the Mechanical Labor Rate of \$125 per hour plus parts.

Battery Systems -

Load test, charge battery, clean terminals, and install. Top off fluid as needed. Replace with new batteries if required.

Engine -

Typical engine commissioning involves: Running engine to proper operating temperature in yard, check for proper cooling and water circulation, check shift and throttle for proper operation, replace tune up parts as needed (spark plugs, filters, distributor caps, etc), and visually check belts and hoses. Additional commissioning steps will vary depending on engine type, make, and model.

Safety Systems -

Inspect, operate, and repair safety items including: bilge pumps, navigation lights, and horn.

Zincs -

Inspect and replace, boat and engine anodes as needed.

☐ **Domestic Systems:** *Work billed at the Mechanical Labor Rate of \$125 per hour plus parts.*

Flush water tanks, purge lines of antifreeze, and check sinks, heads and wash downs for proper operation.

Spring Service & Repair Items: *Work billed at the Mechanical Labor Rate of \$125 per hour plus parts.*

- ☐ Sea Trial Boat. Check for proper operation of all systems.
- ☐ Replace water pump, impellers, and thermostats.
- ☐ Inspect and repair/replace as needed thru hull fittings and sea cocks.
- ☐ Inspect/Replace Cutlass Bearing.
- ☐ Check and adjust stuffing box, replace packing if needed.
- ☐ Sand, prep, and paint outdrive.
- ☐ Service Steering System: (Cable: Inspect: clean, lube, check tension. Hydraulic: Clean, check fittings, seals, and purge hydraulic lines.)
- ☐ Repair and/or Replace Trim Tabs.
- ☐ Outboard Tilt/Trim. Purge hydraulic fluid, replace leaking seals.
- ☐ Check safety and emergency equipment (flares, fire extinguishers, and life jackets)
